

CHS BAND AND COLOR GUARD BOOSTER CLUB

Meeting Minutes
January 10, 2012

OPENING: The January meeting of the CHS Band and Color Guard Booster Club was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the old band hall by L. Dierker, Vice President, as N. Desai, President, was out of town and unable to attend the meeting. L. Dierker noted the December meeting was cancelled.
