Last Meeting Minutes:

Director's Report - Jeff Johnson:

- The Color Guard team achieved a significant milestone by making it to the finals in Austin last week, ranking 17th, which is commendable. Similarly, the Percussion group has been performing well in their competitions, with another one scheduled at the end of Spring break. The current season will conclude at the end of April.
- An Indoor Showcase at CHS has been scheduled for Color Guard and Percussion on 04/04/24, and everyone is welcome to attend.
- Important Pre UIL & UIL dates have been updated in the band app, scheduled for March and April. It is strongly recommended for parents to show their support by attending these events.
- Marching camps are slated for May, with specific dates available in the band app. A parent meeting is scheduled for 05/17/24 along with a showcase. Custom music for next year's show is expected to be ready by May, and the drill will be crafted during the summer break.
- Drum majors for the next academic year were announced last month, and section leaders will be announced post-Spring break.
- Band registration for the next academic year will take place on 05/18/24.
- A select group of band and orchestra students will be performing at the CHS graduation ceremony on 05/25/24.
- Band leadership camp is scheduled after Memorial Day, from 05/28/24 to 05/31/24.
- April & May will be busy months, so it is advised to regularly check the band app for the latest updates and information.

President's Report - Heather Rudolph:

- The Band Banquet is scheduled for 04/26/24. Volunteers will be required, and a signuugenius link will be shared for this purpose.
- The nominating committee is actively seeking volunteers for open positions for the next academic year, including VP Color Guard and Head roles for coolers and first aid. Nominations will be presented in April and subject to voting in May.
- Seniors will be notified to submit their scholarship applications in April. Six scholarships worth \$500 each will be awarded.
- The budget will be presented in April for review and subsequently voted on in May.
- Asha Dale was recognized as the Clements High School VIPS of the month for January.

Treasurer's Report – Asha Dale:

- We are pleased to report that we are currently within budget. The anticipated expenses for the banquet and scholarships amount to \$21,774.
- We have \$9500 remaining for in/out spend, specifically allocated for winter guard and percussion.
